

1. Phoneme Segmentation: Students were asked to count the number of sounds in 21 printed words. Word difficulty varied.

EASY (Clear letter-sound correspondence; Commonly taught digraphs)

cat            Letters: 3      Sounds: 3

show         Letters: 4      Sounds: 2

HARD (Less clear phoneme-grapheme correspondence; 1 letter = 2 sounds)

box           Letters: 3      Sounds: 4

2. Phoneme Matching : Students were asked to identify the word(s) which had the same sound as the one underlined in seven words.

pretend:    basket      baked      thing      battle

3. Phoneme Identification: Students were asked to identify the third sound in six words and provide an example word with that sound circled.

would    D as in DOG
